## 2022-23 BASKETBALL LEAGUE INFORMATION

Church Basketball League places boys and girls ages 4-18 on teams where they will learn to play basketball and compete together in a Christian environment, with an emphasis on teaching them about the love of Christ.

Registration begins in September and ends on October 30th unless the number capacity for an age group has been met. Registration is available after the 8am and 10am services by the Children's Ministry office.

The cost is: 1 child = \$50, 2 children = \$90, 3 children = \$125, 4 children = \$150, 5th child is free. Family discounts are for siblings living in the same household only. Payment is due at registration. Children can't be registered without payment. Checks should be payable to CCP. Most credit cards are accepted.

Age groups are as follows: 4-5s, 6-7s, 8-9s, 10-11s, 12-14s, and 15-18s. September 1st is the date that is used to determine which age group a child plays in. All 18-year-olds must still be in high school.

Players who sign up after their age group is full will be placed on a wait list. Siblings can be on the same team if requested. Other requests cannot be accommodated (i.e. carpooling/friend).

Practices for ages 6-18 are for one hour on Saturdays in December. The 4-5s will practice before games only. Game season starts in January and ends in early March on Saturdays. All games and practices are at Calvary. Ages 4-9 play in the Fellowship Hall (blue gym), ages 10-18 play in the High School Gym.

All players are required to attend team devotions, which will be held before or after each game at the coach's discretion. Participation is not optional.
