2023-24 BASKETBALL LEAGUE INFORMATION

Church Basketball League places boys and girls ages 4-18 on teams where they will learn to play basketball and compete together in a Christian environment, with an emphasis on teaching them about the love of Christ.

The deadline to register is October 22nd. All registration is online. Go to kids.ccphilly.org/sports for more info on how to register.

The cost is: \$50 for 1 child, \$90 for 2 children, \$125 for 3 children, and \$150 for 4 or more children. Anyone who withdraws before the end of registration will receive a full refund. No refunds can be issued once uniforms are ordered (end of October).

There is a \$10 charge to exchange uniforms if a child orders the incorrect size. Sample uniforms for sizing are available outside the Children's Ministry Office on Sunday mornings.

Age groups are as follows: 4-5s, 6-7s, 8-9s, 10-11s, 12-14s, and 15-18s. September 1st is the date that is used to determine which age group a child plays in. All 18-year-olds must still be in high school. Players who sign up after their age group is full will be placed on a wait list.

Girls in the older age groups (12-14s and 15-18s) may request one friend to be on their team, and we will honor that request. Siblings in the same age group will be on the same team, unless otherwise requested. No other requests can be guaranteed.

Practices for ages 6-18 are for one hour on Saturdays in December. The 4-5s will practice before games only. Games are on Saturdays from January until early March. All games and practices are at Calvary. Ages 4-9 play in the Fellowship Hall (blue gym), ages 10-18 play in the High School Gym.

All players are required to attend team devotions, which will be held before or after each game at the coach's discretion. Participation in team devotions is not optional.
