

2024 VBS INFORMATION

VBS this year is July 15th-19th from 9am-12:30pm. Doors open at 9am and drop off is 9-9:25am. Anyone who arrives after 9:25am will drop off at the late table. Pick up begins at 12:30pm. All children must be picked up by 12:40pm.

Registration closes July 11th. All registration is online. Go to kids.ccphilly.org for more info on how to register.

The cost is \$20 for one child or \$50 for a family. After June 30th, the cost is \$30 for one child or \$60 for a family. Family discounts are for siblings living in the same household only.

Only students registered by June 19th will be guaranteed a t-shirt. Any student who registers after that date may receive one while supplies last.

Children from age 4 through those who have just completed 5th grade during the 2023-2024 school year are eligible. A child must be 4 by September 1st, 2024 to be eligible.

Age groups are pre-k/kindergarten, 1st-2nd grade, 3rd-4th grade, and 5th grade. Children are placed in the grade they completed in the 2023-2024 school year.

Each child may request a sibling or friend to be in the same class with, provided they are in the same age group. Note that all 5th graders are in the same class.

Snacks are provided each day. The snacks will be Lay's potato chips, soft pretzels, goldfish, Skinny Pop (popcorn), freeze pops, and fruit snacks. If you have allergy concerns, feel free to contact us with questions.

Each day will include a recreation time. Please dress your child in "active" clothing (sneakers, t-shirts, etc.). Weather permitting, 3rd-5th grade will go outside each day, so dress accordingly.
