



## 2021 SOCCER LEAGUE INFORMATION

Fall Soccer League places boys and girls ages 4-17 on teams where they will learn to play soccer and compete together in a Christian environment, with an emphasis on teaching them about the love of Christ.

Registration begins in April and ends in early June unless number capacity has been met. Registration is available after the 8am and 10am services by the Children's Ministry office.

The cost is: 1 child = \$45, 2 children = \$85, 3 children = \$120, 4 children = \$150, 5th child is free. Family discounts are for siblings living in the same household only. Payment is due at registration. Child cannot be registered without payment. Checks should be payable to CCP. Most credit cards are accepted.

Age groups are as follows: 4-5s, 6-7s, 8-9s, 10-12s, and 13-17s. September 1<sup>st</sup> is the date that is used to determine which age group a child plays in. A child must be 4 years old by September 1<sup>st</sup> to be eligible to play. Players who sign up after their age group is full will be placed on a wait list. No requests other than a sibling or coach/child request will be honored. Cousins are not considered siblings.

Practice for ages 6-17 is one night a week during the month of August. The 4-5s will practice before games only. Game season starts late August and ends in late October. All games are on Saturdays at Calvary.

All players are required to attend team devotions, which will be held before or after each game at the coach's discretion. Participation is not optional.

Shin guards must be worn for all practices and games. Cleats are not required but are highly recommended. If this is a hardship, donated cleats and shin guards are available.

COVID precautions based on the latest state and local regulations will be determined as the season gets closer.
